



Level 2 Certificate in Manufacturing Textile Products (NVQ) (QCF)

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates within the various sectors of the Textile Manufacturing Industry. The job role ideally involves some responsibility and team working.

Course Outline

This qualification (NVQ equivalent) is made up of a minimum of 27 credits, which must include 8 credits from the mandatory units and a minimum of 19 credits from the optional units. The work-related units measure a person's capability and job competency.

There are 2 mandatory units and candidates must also achieve 3 optional units. (See reverse for details)

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by ABC Awards and will have the opportunity to attend a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- Level 3 Diploma in Manufacturing Textile Products
- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Course Delivery: Candidates are assessed in the workplace by qualified assessors. Candidates produce a portfolio of evidence to show knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence can take a variety of formats including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence and case studies

Venue: Onsite at the employer's premises

Duration: Up to 12 months

Cost: No cost to eligible learners aged 16-18 via the Apprenticeship
Employer contribution required for anyone over the age of 19

Course Dates: Candidates can begin this qualification at any point in the calendar year
