

NVQ Level 2 Printing

Course Outline

This qualification is designed to give valuable work based support and accreditation for employees working in the print industry.

The NVQ is made up of a selection of work related units which measure a person's capability and job competency in print manufacture. The NVQs have one mandatory unit and two optional units to cover a cross section of equipment, techniques, job roles and management skills.

Pathways offered by Textile Centre of Excellence are:

- **Pre-press**
- **Machine Printing**
- **Mechanised Print Finishing and Binding**
- **Carton Manufacture**

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, learners will be awarded a certificate approved by City & Guilds and will have the opportunity to attend a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. They will also have the opportunity to progress their learning through NVQ Level 3 in Print or the ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management.

Course Delivery

Learners are assessed in the workplace by qualified print assessors. They produce a portfolio of evidence to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence is gathered using a variety of assessment methods including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence, professional discussion and case studies.

Venue: Onsite at the employer's premises with occasional attendance at our Centre

Duration: Programme length is approximately 10-12 months

Cost: No cost to eligible learners through Train to Gain
