



Level 3 Certificate in Logistics Operations (NVQ – QCF)

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for supervisors within a warehousing environment who wish to have their essential competencies recognised by a national qualification.

Course Outline

The NVQ is made up of 7 work related units (to a minimum of 21 credits), which measure a person's capability and job competency. The qualification is individually designed to match the candidate's job role and knowledge and practical skills development is expected.

There are 3 mandatory units and 4 optional units to be completed (see reverse).

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by the City & Guilds with the opportunity for a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's annual awards ceremony. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Duration:	12 - 18 months
Cost:	Fully funded aged 16-18 via the Advanced Apprenticeship Programme Employer contribution required for anyone over the age of 19
Course Dates:	Candidates can begin this NVQ at any point in the calendar year.
