



NVQ Level 3 Management

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for practising First Line Managers who have a tightly defined area of responsibility; responsibility for achieving results by using resources effectively; some limited opportunity for taking decisions and managing budgets; and responsibility for the allocation of work to team members, colleagues or contractors.

Course Outline

The NVQ is made up of 7 work related units, which measure a person's capability and job competency. There are 4 Mandatory Units and candidates must also achieve 2 optional units.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, Candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by the Institute of Leadership & Management with the opportunity for a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's annual awards ceremony. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:
